

All scholarship entries are confidential and will only be viewed by PREMA, Chadron State College or the Basin Electric Power Cooperative scholarship committees. There are four scholarships available for qualified college sophomore, junior, senior or graduate students. Three scholarships are available to incoming college freshmen. One scholarship to any student attending Chadron State College as well as one scholarship available to a student planning to attend the WNCC Powerline Training School- this scholarship is awarded to either a consumer or an individual that resides within 60mi of Alliance or Hyannis. Repeat (if awarded last year) winners will only be considered if there are not enough non-repeat winners.
